Principal Job Responsibilities

As a Trainee Surfacing Team Leader, you will be trained and required to undertake duties which will include assisting the site operations team / squad in the operation of road surfacing plant and machinery, preparing and laying by machine and by hand, road surfacing materials, as well as general site operations.

Training

Through a 2–3-year traineeship, you'll work on real construction sites, gaining valuable experience in a surfacing squad while progressing through a training programme. You will be trained how to operate specialist surfacing equipment and gain experience in various tasks, from general labouring to roller driving, screw-man, and paver operation. For those showing potential, there's an exciting career path, with the possibility of advancing to roles such as Team Leader, Supervisor, or Surfacing Manager.

Along with on-the-job training, you may be required to attend the National Construction College Scotland, Inchinnan (for 16 weeks of block release over the 2-year period) to undertake a Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Roadbuilding (dependent upon the individual and skills/experience/knowledge).

- Roadbuilding techniques
- Laying surfacing materials
- Preparing and operating road plant or machinery.
